Over the last 17 years, we've grown tremendously and now offer a full array of assessments designed to help not only with diagnostic clarity (we evaluate for learning disabilities, ADHD, Autism Spectrum Disorder, and other psychological challenges), but also to provide an individually tailored battery of tests designed to answer clients' (and their families') specific questions and to illuminate their strengths and weaknesses. We have trained students from many prestigious universities, including the University of California at Berkeley, DePaul University, and Fuller Graduate School. We accept applications year-round for training opportunities on our Assessment Team. These opportunities include:

What We Offer

Learning to do psychological assessments is an exciting commitment. Training opportunities will include the following components:

- Weekly individual supervision with Dr. Jocelin Saks, Director of the Assessment Clinic at Clearwater
- Monthly participation in an assessment consultation groups with senior clinicians outside of Clearwater
- Learning to administer and score a variety of assessment measures, including but not limited to those evaluating cognitive abilities, memory, academic skills, and attention/concentration
- Working with clients and families to complete cognitive educational assessments, which includes leading intake interviews, planning the testing protocol, administering and scoring test materials, writing comprehensive reports, and conducting feedback sessions
